SECURITY BADGE APPLICATION INSTRUCTION SHEET AND CHECKLIST:

Please follow these instructions completely. Failure to properly complete the paperwork in this packet will significantly delay your application process.

SECURITY BADGE APPLICATION FORM:

PART I: You must fill in all the blanks in Part I (the entire front of the Application Form). This part includes necessary personal information, as well as an inquiry into any past criminal activity. You must sign at the bottom of the page, signifying that you read and understood the information, and that all the information you provided was correct and accurate.

PART II: The "Authorized Issuer" must complete Part II (the upper half on the reverse side of the Application Form). The Authorized Issuer is the person employed by each Airport tenant/user who is responsible for requesting Security Badges for that tenant/user's employees. The Authorized Issuer is also responsible for the accountability of Security Badges issued to that tenant/user. The Authorized Issuer will usually be a Station Manager, Manager of Operations, or the equivalent for each Airport tenant/user. This person must fill out Part II completely.

PART III: Part III is for Airport Authority Use only. DO NOT fill in any of the blanks in Part III.

PART IV: Part IV must be completed by the Authorized Issuer. It is in reference to escorting procedures.

YOU MUST BRING THE COMPLETED APPLICATION FORM SIGNED BY YOUR AUTHORIZED ISSUER, THE NECESSARY PAYMENT FOR FEES, ALONG WITH TWO FORMS OF ACCEPTABLE ID TO THE AIRPORT OPERATIONS DEPARTMENT FOR REVIEW PRIOR TO BEING FINGERPRINTED.

ACCESS INVESTIGATION:

YOU WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR PASSING A FINGERPRINT-BASED CRIMINAL HISTROY RECORDS CHECK IN ACCORDANCE WITH 49 CFR 1542.209 AND YOU WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO ATTEND THE SECURITY TRAINING CLASS AND/OR RECEIVE YOUR BADGE UNTIL THE CHECK IS PROCESSED.

AIRPORT SECURITY BADGE: LETTER OF INSTRUCTION

- 1. All Airport Security Badges remain the property of the Gulfport-Biloxi Regional Airport Authority. The Airport will charge a fee for each Airport Security Badge issued. There will be a \$15.00 renewal fee each time an Airport Security Badge is renewed, replaced, or reprinted for any reason. The \$15.00 fee is not included in the lost or stolen badge fee of \$50.00.
- 2. Badge Applicants required to be fingerprinted by the TSA or Airport Authority must pay a fee of \$32.00 will be charged for each applicant. A copy of the criminal record received from the FBI will be provided to the individual, if requested by the individual in writing. Badges which are expired over 30 calendar days require reprinting at a cost of \$32.00.
- 3. The total cost for the initial badge and fingerprinting is \$55.00.
- 4. **The individual to whom a Security Badge is issued is responsible for the proper use and safeguarding of the Badge.** Failure to properly safeguard the use and control of the Security Badge may result in the implementation of disciplinary actions against the Badge holder.
- 5. Gulfport-Biloxi International Airport Security Badges are not transferable between employees.
- 6. Gulfport-Biloxi International Airport Security Badges must be visibly displayed above the waist on the outermost garment when on the Secured Area, S.I.D.A., or Sterile Area. Security Badges will be produced immediately for display when requested on Non-Secured Areas.
- 7. Airport users are responsible to ensure a portal is closed and secured upon passage. When walking through a pedestrian portal, a user must physically pull on the portal to ensure the locking mechanism has engaged.
- 8. Once a user accesses a portal, it is his/her responsibility to ensure the portal is secured. Responsibility for an open portal cannot be delegated to another user.
- 9. The Airport Operations Office must be notified **immediately** (at the moment) of the loss or theft of a Security Badge. This initial notification must be made verbally, whether by phone or in person. Within three days, a "Lost/Stolen Security Report Form" must be filed with the Operations Office. A \$50.00 fine will be levied for all lost Security Badges. A fine of \$100.00 per Badge will be levied for any employee's second Badge loss. There will be an additional fee of \$15.00 for replacement of the badge which is not included in the \$50.00 fine.
- 10. In the event of any change in the employment work status (such as transfers or termination), the Badge holder is responsible for immediately (within minutes) returning the Security Badge to the "Authorized Issuer", who will then return the Badge to the Airport Operations Department. It is the Authorized Issuer's responsibility to insure that all badges issued to his or her company are accounted for. A \$100.00 fine will be levied for Badges that are not properly returned.
- 11. The Gulfport-Biloxi Regional Airport Authority reserves the right to revoke the authorization of any Airport User, tenant, agency **or individual** for an Airport Security Badge when such an action is determined to be in the best interest of the Airport Security Program.
- 12. SCREENING NOTICE: Any employee holding a credential granting access to a Security Identification Display Area may be screened at any time while gaining access to, working in, or leaving a Security Identification Display Area.

What is an FBI Identity History Summary?



An FBI Identity History Summary, often referred to as a "rap sheet," is a listing of certain information taken from fingerprint submissions kept by the FBI. The information is related to arrests, and in some instances, the information is related to federal employment, naturalization, or military service. If the fingerprint submissions are related to an arrest, the Identity History Summary includes the name of the agency that submitted the fingerprints to the FBI,

the date of the arrest, the arrest charge, and the disposition of the arrest, if known. All arrest information included in an Identity History Summary is obtained from fingerprint submissions, disposition reports, and other information submitted by authorized criminal justice agencies.

How do I challenge my FBI Identity History Summary?

If you believe your Identity History Summary contains inaccurate or incomplete information, you may request a change or correction by contacting the agency or agencies that originally submitted the information to the FBI. However, most states require that changes to Identity History Summary Information be processed through their respective state centralized agency (State Identification Bureau). You may contact the respective State Identification Bureau for assistance, and, if applicable, request they provide the FBI with updates to your Identity History Summary. For the State Identification Bureau listing, refer to: www.fbi.gov/checks.

You may also send an electronic or written challenge request to the FBI's CJIS Division. Your written request should clearly identify the information that you feel is inaccurate or incomplete and should include copies of any available proof or supporting documentation that validates your claim. For example, if your disposition information is incorrect or missing.

you may submit documentation obtained from the court having control over the arrest or the office prosecuting the offense. The FBI will contact the appropriate agencies in an attempt to verify or correct challenged entries for you. Upon receipt of an official communication from the agency with control over the data, the FBI will make appropriate changes and notify you of the outcome. Updating your FBI Identity History Summary can include having final disposition data entered, cases expunged, pardons entered, a conviction level changed, or rights restored. Once you have been notified of the outcome of your challenge, you may choose to obtain a copy of your Identity History Summary. Please see "How do I obtain a copy of my FBI Identity History Summary for personal review" in this brochure.

Option 2: Submit your request directly to the FBI:

FBI CJIS Division - Summary Request 1000 Custer Hollow Road Clarksburg, WV 26306

You are required to provide the following:

- 1) A completed Applicant Information Form.
- 2) Payment for the \$18 processing fee, either by certified check or money order made payable to the Treasury of the United States, or by a credit card. For credit card payment form and information, refer to: www.fbi.gov/checks.
- 3) A current fingerprint card bearing your name and date of birth. You must include rolled impressions of all 10 fingerprints and impressions of all 10 fingerprints taken at the same time (these are sometimes referred to as plain or flat impressions). If possible, have your fingerprints taken by a fingerprinting technician. Previously processed cards or copies will not be accepted.

Option 3: Submit through an FBI-approved Channeler, which is a private business that has contracted with the FBI to submit your request on your behalf. The Channeler will then receive the electronic summary check results for dissemination to the individual. For a listing of FBI-approved Channelers, refer to: www.fbi.gov/checks.

Due to provisions within the Privacy Act of 1974, the FBI cannot provide Identity History Summary information via the telephone or facsimile.

What will I receive?

If we do not find an Identity History Summary on file, you will receive a response indicating that you have no prior arrest data on file at the FBI. If you do have an Identity History Summary on file, you will receive your Identity History Summary or "rap sheet."

If you submitted a request electronically directly to the FBI, you will receive a response electronically and an option for a response by First-Class Mail via the U.S. Postal Service.

If you submitted a request through the mail directly to the FBI, you will receive a response by First-Class Mail via the U.S. Postal Service.

Frequently Asked Questions

What is the processing time?

The FBI processes requests as quickly as possible; however, please allow several weeks for processing. The processing time will be less if your request is submitted electronically. Requests submitted to the FBI are processed in the date order they are received. You may obtain an estimate of the current processing time on our website; refer to www.fbi.gov/checks.

Can the FBI send the results to someone (or an agency) other than myself?

Under the U.S. Department of Justice Order 556-73, the results will be returned to the requestor or his/her designated representative. A signed release to return the results to the representative must accompany such a request.

Where can I get my fingerprints taken?

Local, county, or state law enforcement agencies may take your fingerprints for a fee. Also, some private companies offer this service. Check the business listings in your telephone book or search online. If using the Channeler option, please contact the FBI-approved Channeler for additional information.

Why was I told there was a problem with my Identity History Summary when I received a letter indicating that a search of the fingerprints I provided revealed no prior arrest data at the FBI?

There are several instances in which this might occur, such as:

- I) Removal of arrest information may have been authorized since you were advised of the summary problem.
- A previous search was conducted with a name and physical description only, and the descriptive data you provided matched or was very similar to that contained in another individual's summary. Positive identifications are made by fingerprint comparisons.
- 3) The arresting agency may not have supplied the information to the FBI. You will need to contact the state repository of the state in which the arrest occurred.
